
We hereby certify that the above consignment was scoured on these premises on 16/02/2017 through a set of 5 wash bowls at temperatures ranging from 60 to 70 degrees centigrade. The total immersion time was approximately 7 minutes. The first 3 bowls were charged with a biodegradable alcohol ethoxylate detergent and sodium carbonate. The final rinse bowl was controlled to a neutral pH by the addition of formic acid.

The wool was then passed through a dryer at temperatures ranging from approximately 65 to 95 degrees centigrade for a period of approximately 3 minutes.

All the wool in the consignment was therefore subjected to heat treatment in which the centre was raised to temperatures of at least 70 degrees centigrade.

- i) the wool was scoured according to an approved process in an approved establishment
- ii) the scoured wool is free from blood and pieces of skin
- iii) the scoured wool did not come into contact with raw materials prior to export.

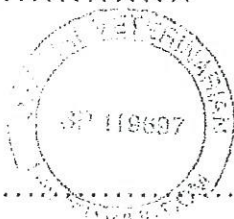
IV. HEALTH INFORMATION

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, authorized thereto by the Veterinary Authority of the United Kingdom, certify the following with regards to the consignment described in Section I:

- 1. the wool originates from live animals that, at the time of shearing, were part of a flock that was not subject to movement restrictions for the control of Anthrax;
- 2. the United Kingdom is officially free of Foot and Mouth disease, Vesicular Stomatitis, Rinderpest and Sheep Pox;
- 3. East Coast Fever has not been recorded in the United Kingdom during the last 12 months;
- 4. in the case of scoured wool: the wool was scoured at an approved establishment, which consisted of the immersion of wool in a water-soluble detergent held at 60-70°C, and the scoured wool did not come into contact with raw materials prior to export;
- 5. the consignment is securely packed in sound bales, packages or cases and no second-hand packaging material has been used.
